About the Montpelier Bean Feast

The Montpelier Bean Feast can trace its origins back to the 18th Century when Thomas Rennison, owner of The Old England Pub, held a fete filled with merriment and high jinks, with a little dig at 'those in charge'. It was reborn a few years ago as a community party to celebrate local heritage, harvest and creative genius. We celebrate with creative workshops and entertaining games for children and adults, live local music, a bike repair station, vegetable revelry, tea & cake, street food, a clothes freecycle and a market (of which you may be part!). On average, about 800-1000 people come through the event during the day.

Rules for Craft Stallholders

- **No cakes or other food/drink can be sold from your stall as the Montpelier Beanfeast Cafe will be selling tea & cake from which profits go to covering the running costs of the event. You're very welcome to donate cakes of course to help the fundraising efforts!**
- You are expected to provide your own trestle or table / gazebo / suitcase / bicycle basket (unless otherwise arranged with the organisers)
- For the 3x3 metre stall, if you wish to erect a gazebo or take up more than the allocated space, then you need to tell us this in advance. Not permitted for smaller pitches.
- You are only permitted to sell goods from your allocated site.
- Stalls may be set up from 11am. All cars/vans must be off site from 12 noon. Stall must be set up by 12:45. Trading runs from 1-6pm.
- No parking for stallholders on site and for safety reasons, please do not park anywhere immediately outside the park on St Andrews Road. The only real entrance with a car is at the bottom near the basketball pitch.
- You can pack down from 6pm and you should be able to bring vehicles back onto the site shortly after this time (exact timings to be confirmed by stewards).
- If it rains, there are no alternative facilities for stallholders but we don't plan to cancel the event so money is not returnable (apologies for any inconvenience).
- If proceeds from your stall are going to a charity or good cause, please advertise this on your stall.
- Please make payment within 1 week of approval of your application. We will provide bank details.
